Believe

Read John 20:29. Thomas had a hard time believing Jesus was alive. He knew Jesus had died, but Jesus came to Thomas and showed him the truth. Sometimes we can be like Thomas. Thankfully, Jesus is patient with us, too.

LOOK to Jesus to help answer your questions when you ask.





We often have a lot of questions about Jesus. Know that no matter what your questions are, you can pray about them. Often, God will give us the answers through what we read in the Bible or putting trusted adults in our lives to help us. Pray and ask God to help you with your big questions.
