Perfect Plan

Good News Travels Fast

Waiting can be hard, like staring at wrapped presents and wondering what's inside! God's people waited hundreds of years for Jesus, but His timing was perfect. When plans feel slow, waiting for your turn on the swing or for cookies to bake, remember God always planned to send Jesus. Think about a seed hiding in dirt before a flower pops up—God works while we wait!

With a grown-up, set a timer for two minutes. While you wait, name promises God keeps (love, help, forgiveness). You can even ask your grown-up to help you think of some.

ASK God to help you trust Him while you wait.

Steady Plan

When you stack blocks into a tall tower, you have a plan about which block you will put on next and where. But towers can wobble and fall. God's plan never wobbles! Long ago, He promised to send Jesus, and nothing could stop that promise. When Mary heard God's plan, she trusted God even without knowing how everything would happen. When you feel unsure, like trying a new game or going somewhere new, remember Christmas. Jesus is proof that God keeps every promise exactly at the right time.

KNOW that God's plan is always good and sure.

Joyful Song

Hold your hands like a megaphone and shout, "GOODNEWS"! Long before newspapers or phones, God wrote His plan to send Jesus. Nothing could erase it. When the angel spoke and Jesus was born, every word came true. Think about one promise God makes to you: He loves you, helps you, and stays with you. God keeps His promises. THANK GOD for keeping His promises and for sending Jesus today.
