DAY 1

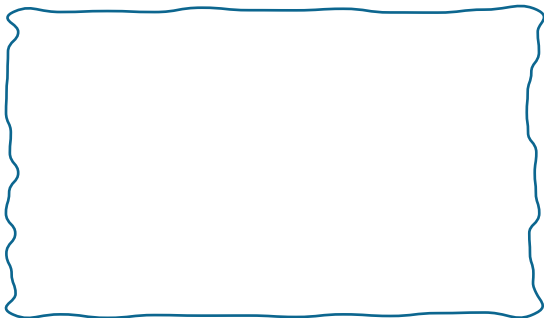
Small Starts, Big Kingdom

Read Matthew 13:31-32 NIrV

God’s kingdom doesn’t always start in big, loud ways. Sometimes it begins quietly. Jesus shows us that God cares about small things that grow. A kind word. A prayer. A good choice. These may seem tiny, but God uses them in powerful ways. You don’t have to be famous or strong to live out God’s kingdom. God works through your everyday choices. When you help someone, forgive someone, or tell the truth, you show what God’s kingdom is like. God can take small beginnings and grow them into something beautiful. Keep seeking God’s kingdom. God is doing more than you can see.

On-Page Activity: Kingdom Growth Path

Draw a small seed at the bottom of the page and a tall plant at the top. Along the stem, write three small actions you can take this week that show God’s kingdom.



DAY 2

God Is Always Working

Read Philippians 1:6 NIrV

When you begin your Kingdom Quest, God begins working in your heart. Sometimes that work is easy to see. Other times it’s slow and quiet. Even when you feel stuck, God is still working. Seeking God’s kingdom means trusting that He is shaping you every day. Growth takes time, but God never gives up. Keep choosing what is right. Keep loving others. God is growing something good in you.

At-Home Activity:

With an adult, talk about something you have learned over time. Then talk about one way God is helping you grow in your faith.

Jesus shows us God’s kingdom.



DAY 3

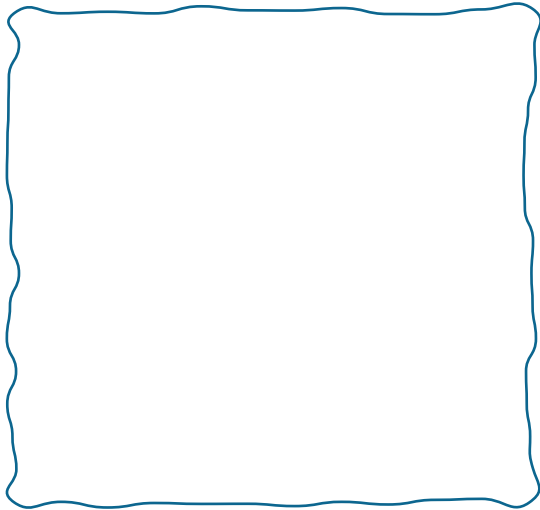
Growing God's Way

Read Colossians 2:6-7 NIrV

Seeking God's kingdom means staying connected to Jesus. Just like roots help a plant grow strong, Jesus helps your faith grow. When you pray and learn God's Word, you grow closer to Him. God's kingdom grows in your life one step at a time. Keep growing. God is guiding you on your Kingdom Quest.

Personal Reflection:

Write or draw one way you want to grow closer to God. Ask God to help you take the next step.



DAY 4

Showing the Kingdom

Read Matthew 5:16 NIrV

Where do you go? School? The store? Soccer practice? Did you know you can shine God's light at school, at the park, at practice, and at home? You can! Loving others and living like Jesus is part of your Kingdom Quest. Wherever you go, you can show people what God's kingdom is like. So start your quest, and shine the light of Jesus!

Pray this:
