ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, slowly walk toward them and say: "Good morning! I see someone who Jesus loves. And...it's...YOU! (*Cuddle your child.*) Jesus loves [child's name]!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You that [child's name] and I get to love each other. Help us love like Jesus starting right here in our own home."



Drive Time

While on the go, look for helpers, like construction workers, paramedics, fire fighters, truck drivers, mail carriers, school bus drivers, etc. When you see a helper, say, "Helper!" and clap for them. Talk about how helping others is one way we can love like Jesus.



Bath Time

Add foam hearts and a scoop to bath time. Encourage your child to scoop the floating hearts and then line the hearts up on the edge of the tub. Tell them to say, "I can love like Jesus" each time they touch a heart. (If you don't have foam hearts, cut some out of a sponge.)
